<p>MSDS and Informational Updates</p> <p>First Delivery of Medication</p> <p>Subsequent Deliveries of Same Medication</p>	<p>The dispensing pharmacy shall provide a set of material safety data sheets (MSDS) for all hazardous medications dispensed by the dispensing pharmacy, as defined by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Policy Interpretation and Implementation</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The pharmacy shall provide MSDSs and informational updates, as appropriate, for all medications that are considered hazardous. 2. An MSDS must accompany the first delivery of the medication. 3. After the initial delivery, the MSDS does not have to be redistributed unless there is a change in the MSDS.
